**United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) (Amendment)
Regulation 2026**

(Made by the Chief Executive under section 3 of the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) on the instruction of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and after consultation with the Executive Council)

1. United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation amended

The United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CO) is amended as set out in sections 2 to 5.

2. Section 1 amended (interpretation)

(1) Section 1—

Repeal the definition of *arms or related materiel*

Substitute

“*arms or related materiel* (軍火或相關物資) includes—

- (a) weapons and ammunition of all types (including small arms, light weapons and their ammunition);
- (b) any military vehicle, military equipment or paramilitary equipment; and
- (c) any spare part for any item specified in paragraphs (a) and (b);”.

(2) Section 1—

Add in alphabetical order

“**Resolution 2794** (《第2794號決議》) means Resolution 2794 (2025) adopted by the Security Council on 17 October 2025;”.

3. Section 2 amended (limited duration of certain provisions)

- (1) Section 2(4), after “Regulation 2025”—

Add

“(L.N. 76 of 2025)”.

- (2) After section 2(4)—

Add

“(5) Sections 3, 4, 5A, 6, 7, 8AA, 8AB and 8 are in force during the period from the commencement of the United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) (Amendment) Regulation 2026 until midnight on 16 October 2026.”.

4. Section 7 amended (entry or transit of persons prohibited)

- (1) Section 7(5), definition of *specified person*, paragraph (a)—

Repeal

“or”.

- (2) Section 7(5), definition of *specified person*, paragraph (b)—

Repeal

“Resolution 2653.”

Substitute

“Resolution 2653; or”.

- (3) Section 7(5), definition of *specified person*, after paragraph (b)—

Add

“(c) an individual listed in the Annex to Resolution 2794.”.

“(c) an individual listed in the Annex to Resolution 2794.”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Cap. 537 sub. leg. CO) (*principal Regulation*) to give effect to certain decisions in respect of Haiti in Resolution 2794 (2025) adopted by the Security Council of the United Nations on 17 October 2025.

2. Section 3 of this Regulation amends section 2 of the principal Regulation to provide that sections 3, 4, 5A, 6, 7 (as amended by this Regulation), 8AA, 8AB and 8 of the principal Regulation (*relevant provisions*) are in force until midnight on 16 October 2026.
3. The relevant provisions give effect to the prohibition against—
 - (a) the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of arms or related materiel to Haiti;
 - (b) the provision of technical assistance, training or financial or other assistance related to military activities, or related to the provision, maintenance or use of arms or related materiel, to Haiti;
 - (c) making available to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities any funds or other financial assets or economic resources (*economic assets*);
 - (d) dealing with economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by, certain persons or entities; and
 - (e) entry into or transit through the HKSAR by certain persons.
