

**L.N. 205 of 2002****SECURITIES AND FUTURES (REGISTRATION OF APPEALS  
TRIBUNAL ORDERS) RULES**

(Made under section 233 of the Securities and Futures  
Ordinance (Cap. 571))

**1. Commencement**

These Rules shall come into operation on the day appointed for the commencement of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571).

**2. Interpretation**

In these Rules—

“order” (命令) means an order of the Tribunal made under the Ordinance;

“Tribunal” (審裁處) means the Securities and Futures Appeals Tribunal established by section 216 of the Ordinance.

**3. Registration of Tribunal orders in  
Court of First Instance**

The Tribunal shall, for the purpose of giving notice in respect of an order pursuant to section 226 of the Ordinance, produce to the Registrar of the High Court a notice in writing requesting that the order be registered, together with the order and a copy of the order.
