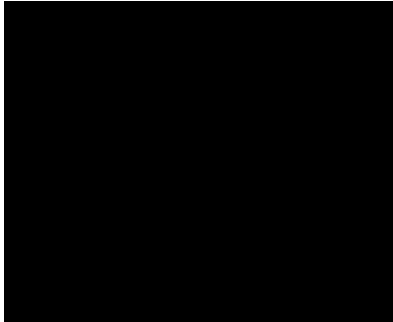

**Appointment as a Non-Executive Director of
MEGAIN Holding (Cayman) Co., Ltd. (the "Company")
有关委任 MEGAIN Holding (Cayman) Co., Ltd. (“本公司”) 非执行董事**

We confirm the terms and conditions of your appointment as a non-executive director of the Company as follows:

我们确认阁下为本公司非执行董事之委任的条款及条件如下：

1. Your appointment as a non-executive director of the Company is for a fixed term of three years with effect from the date of this appointment letter, subject to retirement by rotation and re-election by the shareholders of the Company at the annual general meeting in accordance with the articles of association of the Company (the “**Articles**”), as well as paragraphs 9 and 10 below.
阁下获委任为本公司非执行董事，任期为本委任函之日起三年，惟该委任须根据本公司的组织章程细则(“**章程细则**”)于股东周年大会上轮值退任及重选，以及受限于下文第9及10段。
2. During the term of appointment, you confirm that you shall devote time and effort to perform your duties faithfully and loyally to the Company and to fulfill the duties of care, skill and fiduciary as a director, and shall use your best endeavors to promote and protect the business and interest of the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively, the “**Group**”), and shall not perform or engage in any acts that will damage the interest of the Company or the Group. The Company may from time to time request for your advice or consultation.
在委任期间，阁下确认对本公司负有诚信与勤勉的义务，须竭尽所能促进及保护本公司及本公司之附属公司（统称“**集团**”）的利益，并正当、忠诚、有效率地履行阁下职责，并不会从事或进行任何会损害本公司或集团利益的活动。本公司将不时要求阁下给予意见或咨询。
3. You shall exercise the power delegated to you by the board of directors of the Company (the “**Board**”) and perform the duties delegated to you by the Board from time to time. You shall act in accordance with the instructions given by the Board

(provide that such instructions does not violate the terms contained herein).

閣下亦应行使本公司董事会（“**董事会**”）随时授予的权利，履行董事会随时交托予閣下之职务，并遵照董事会随时给予的指示（该等指示与本委任函条件相符合）行事。

4. Your appointment hereunder is not a full-time position. However, you are required to provide sufficient time and attention to the matters of the Company to discharge your duties. Moreover, you shall not, without the prior written consent of the Board, directly or indirectly, either on your own account or on behalf of any other person, company, business entity or other organization, provide services to (whether as employee, officer, director, agent, partner, consultant or otherwise) any other business which is in competition with the business of the Group.

閣下的委任，并非全职性质。但閣下对本公司之事务，须投入充分的时间及关注，以履行閣下的职责。同时，閣下不能于未取得董事会之书面同意前，直接或间接地，以閣下本人或其他任何人、公司、商业组织或其它机构的名义，通过作为职工、员工、董事、代理、合伙人、顾问或其它形式，向与本集团构成竞争性业务之任何商业机构提供服务。

5. You shall comply to the best of your ability, and use your best endeavours to procure the Company and any alternate of yours and to comply with the relevant requirements under the Companies Ordinance (Chapter 622 of the Laws of Hong Kong), the Companies (Winding Up and Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance (Chapter 32 of the Laws of Hong Kong), the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong), the Codes on Takeovers and Mergers and Share Buy-backs promulgated by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong, the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities (the “**Listing Rules**”) on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) (including the Model Code for Securities Transactions by Directors of Listed Issuers as set out in Appendix C3 to the Listing Rules) and all other applicable laws, regulations, codes of practice and rules in effect from time to time, and the Articles and the resolutions passed in Board meetings and general meetings (to the extent applicable) of the Company.

閣下必须尽力遵守，并尽力促使本公司及其任何替任人遵守《公司条例》（香港法例第 622 章）、《证券及期货条例》（香港法例第 571 章）、《公司（清盘及杂项条文）条例》（香港法例第 32 章）、香港证券及期货事务监察委员会颁布的《公司收购、合并及股份回购守则》、《香港联合交易所有限公司（“**联交所**”）证券主板上市规则》（“**上市规则**”）（包括上市规则附录 C3 所载的《上市发行人董事进行证券交易的标准守则》）及所有其他不时有效的适用法律、法规、守则及规则，及章程细则及在董事会及本公司股东大会（在适用的情况下）通过的决议。

6. In order to satisfy the requirements of a public company, you are expected to attend general meetings of the Company, meetings of the Board and of any Board committees to which you are appointed as a member. You should also keep the Company informed of your other professional commitments, and if there are any changes to any of your significant commitments, you should inform the Board in a timely manner of such changes.

就遵守有关公众公司的规定，閣下须参与本公司的股东大会，董事会会议及任何閣下被委任为成员的董事会委员会之会议。閣下应知会本公司閣下的其他专

业承担，并且如阁下所负的重大承担有任何变动，应就有关变动及时通知董事会。

7. In consideration of the provision of the services described herein, you will be paid HK\$12,000 per month with effect from the date of your appointment. Where the service of appointment hereunder is for a term of less than one month, such monthly fee will be paid on a pro rata basis. You will also be fully reimbursed for all reasonable travel, dining and accommodation expenses you incur in discharging your duties as a non-executive director, and such reimbursements will be paid to you upon production of appropriate proofs of payment and in accordance with the Company's procedures. For the avoidance of doubt, no additional fees will be provided for your being appointed as a member of any committees of the Board.

作为提供本委任函内所描述的服务的代价，阁下将被支付每个月薪金为港币12,000元，自阁下获委任当日起生效。如根据本委任函项下的委任期是少于一个月，该每月薪金则按比例支付。所有阁下于履行阁下作为非执行董事之职责的活动而合理产生的交通费、餐费及住宿费用将被全额补偿，但阁下需提供适当的付款证明及遵守本公司有关程序。为免生疑问，所有阁下被委任为董事会委员会成员的职务将不会获得额外报酬。

8. You undertake and confirm that you shall not, during the term of the appointment as a non-executive director and for a period of twelve (12) months after the termination of the appointment contemplated hereunder, carry on or be engaged in any business which shall be in competition with the business of the Company or the Group or solicit any title or post from any company or individual that is in competition with the business of the Company or the Group, and shall not take up any title or post from any company or individual that is in competition with the business of the Company or the Group.

阁下承诺及保证在受委任为本公司非执行董事期间以及在与本公司之委任关系结束后的十二(12)个月内，阁下将不得以任何方式从事与本公司或集团竞争之业务或向任何与本公司或集团之业务有竞争的公司或个人谋取任何身份或职位，亦不得接受任何与本公司或集团业务有竞争的公司或个人所提供的任何身份或职位。

9. In addition to the requirements as set out in paragraph 1 of this appointment letter, your appointment will at all times be terminable by three months' prior written notice given by either side. Upon the expiry of notice served on you to terminate your appointment, you will resign from your office as a non-executive director (and from each and every other office or appointment you then hold in or on behalf of the Company or any subsidiary of the Company) and, if you have not done so within seven days, you hereby irrevocably appoint any one of your fellow directors for the time being as your attorney to effect such resignation(s) on your behalf by signing any document(s) and doing any other act(s) or thing(s) as may be necessary or required. Upon your resignation as a non-executive director of the Company, you are required to provide the Company and the Stock Exchange the reason for the resignation. For a period of three years from the date on which you cease to be a non-executive director of the Company, you shall inform the Stock Exchange of any change to your contact information, including your telephone number, mobile phone number, facsimile number (if available), email address (if available), residential address and correspondence address, as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event within 28 days of such change.

除了于本委任函第一段所列出的规定外，阁下之聘任将于任何时候由任何一方给予三个月书面通知而终止。于发出予阁下终止阁下之委任的通知届满时，阁下须辞任阁下为非执行董事之职位（及所有阁下在本公司或任何本公司的附属公司或代表本公司或任何本公司的附属公司职位或委任）及，如阁下于七日内并没有作出上述行动，阁下在此不可被撤销地委任任何一位其它董事在此时为阁下之委托人代表阁下签署任何有关办理该辞任所需的文件或作出任何所需的行动或事项。在阁下辞任为非执行董事的同时，阁下必须向公司及联交所提供辞任的理由。自阁下辞任为非执行董事之日起三年内，如阁下联络资料有变，应在合理可行情况下尽快（有关变动出现后 28 日内）向联交所提供阁下最新的资料，包括电话号码、手机号码、传真号码(如有)、电邮地址(如有) 及联络地址。

10. Your appointment will terminate automatically without any requirement for notice or compensation if you:

阁下之委任将无需任何通知或赔偿而被终止，如阁下：

- 10.1 vacate your office under the terms of the Articles;
根据本公司章程细则的条款离职；
- 10.2 are removed from office as a non-executive director by any resolution duly proposed and resolved by the members of the Company in general meeting;
被本公司股东于股东大会有效地建议及议决的决议免去阁下之职位；
- 10.3 are not re-elected as a non-executive director when you submit yourself to re-election;
参与重选时并没有被重选为非执行董事；
- 10.4 are in breach of your obligations as a non-executive director;
违反阁下作为非执行董事的义务；
- 10.5 are adjudicated bankrupt by a court or reach a scheme of arrangement with the creditors;
被法庭宣布破产或与债权人达成还款安排或债务和解；
- 10.6 cause disrepute to the Company or any company within the Group, or cause harm to the interest or business of the Company or the Group as a result of your acts or omissions;
阁下之作为或不作为使本公司或集团任何公司名誉严重蒙污，或损害本公司或集团的利益或业务；
- 10.7 are prohibited by the applicable law from acting as a director;
被适用的法例禁止阁下担任董事的职务；
- 10.8 are convicted of any criminal offence involving your integrity or honesty;
被裁定犯有涉及阁下的品格或诚信的刑事罪行；
- 10.9 become prohibited by any rules, regulations or practice directions of the Stock Exchange from acting as a director; or

被联交所任何规则、规例或应用指引禁止阁下担任非执行董事的职务；
或

10.10 commit a serious breach of the terms of this appointment letter.
严重违反本委任函的条款。

11. Your fiduciary duties to the Company require you at all times:
阁下对本公司的受信责任于任何时间为：

11.1 to maintain the confidentiality of all information you acquire by virtue of your appointment;
对一切因阁下之委任而得到的资料保持保密；

11.2 to act in good faith in the Company's interests at all times;
于任何时候本着真诚为本公司之利益办事；

11.3 to act at all times for the proper purposes of the Company;
于任何时候为本公司恰当的目标办事；

11.4 to carry out your responsibilities with the care, skill and diligence which the Company is reasonably entitled to expect from someone of your experience and expertise; and
以本公司合理地预期从阁下的经验及专门知识应有的谨慎，技巧及勤勉履行阁下之责任；及

11.5 to act only with the proper authority of the Company.
只会于本公司有效的授权下办事。

12. You confirm that prior to your appointment you have obtained legal advice from a firm of solicitors qualified to advise on Hong Kong law as regards the requirements under the Listing Rules that are applicable to you as a non-executive director of a listed issuer and the possible consequences of making a false declaration or giving false information to the Stock Exchange.
阁下承诺及保证在获委任生效前已向有资格就香港法律提供意见的律师行取得法律意见，明白上市规则中所有适用于其作为上市发行人非执行董事的规定，以及向联交所作出虚假声明或提供虚假信息所可能引致的后果。

13. If any circumstances should arise in which it becomes necessary for you to seek separate independent professional and/or legal advice about your responsibilities as a non-executive director of the Company, you will be reimbursed for your reasonable professional and/or legal costs of doing so.
如有任何情况发生导致阁下必须就有关阁下为本公司非执行董事的责任征询独立专业及/或法律意见，阁下将就阁下有关上述事项而产生的合理专业及/或法律费用获得补偿。

14. You shall disclose to the Board all other directorships and other (direct and/or indirect) interests, employment, consultancies or associations held by you or members of your family. You must also keep the Board informed on a continuing basis of all changes to such arrangements.

阁下须向董事会披露阁下或阁下家庭之成员所任职的所有董事职位及其它（直接及/或间接）利益、受雇职位、顾问或社团。阁下必须持续地知会董事会任何有关上述的变更。

15. You shall not, either during the term of your appointment as a non-executive director of the Company or thereafter:

阁下将不可，于阁下被委任为本公司非执行董事的期间内或以后：

- 14.1 use to the detriment or prejudice of the Company or divulge or communicate to any person any trade secret or confidential information concerning the business or affairs of the Company (except to employees or directors of the Company whose province is to know the same) which may have come to your knowledge during the term of your appointment hereunder; or

对本公司损害或不利地使用或泄露或与任何人士沟通就有关阁下于本函所述的委任期内所得悉的任何本公司有关业务或事务的商业机密或机密资料（除了本公司已知悉上述数据的任何董事或员工外）；或

- 14.2 use for your own purpose or for any purposes other than those of the Company or disclose to any third party any information or knowledge of a confidential nature which you may from time to time acquire from the Company or any subsidiary of the Company but so that this restriction shall cease to apply to any information or knowledge which may come into the public domain (otherwise than through your default).

将任何阁下不时取得有关本公司或任何本公司的附属公司属机密性质的数据或知识用于私人目的或任何其它非为达成本公司目的的目的或披露予任何第三方，但本规限将不受限于在公众领域可取得的任何数据或知识（除了由于阁下的违规而所导致外）。

16. You shall, whether when you are a non-executive director of the Company or after ceasing to be so, (1) provide any information and documents or explanation to the Stock Exchange and the Securities and Futures Commission pursuant to 3.09C(1) of the Listing Rules, and (2) cooperate in any investigation conducted by the Listing Division of the Stock Exchange and/or the Listing Committee of the Stock Exchange or the Securities and Futures Commission pursuant to 3.09(2) of the Listing Rules.

阁下在出任本公司非执行董事时以及停止担任本公司非执行董事后均须(1)依上市规则第3.09C(1)条向联交所及证券及期货事务监察委员会提供任何数据及文件或解释，及(2)依上市规则第3.09C(2)条在联交所的上市科及/或联交所上市委员会或证券及期货事务监察委员会所进行的任何调查中给予合作。

17. You shall promptly upon request by the Company or in any event upon your ceasing to be a non-executive director of the Company deliver to the Company or at the request of the Company destroy all lists of clients or customers, correspondence and all other documents, papers and records which may have been prepared by you or have come into your possession as a director of the Company, and you shall not be entitled to and shall not retain any copies thereof. Title and copyright therein shall vest in the Company.

阁下须迅速地在本公司要求下或无论如何在下不再为本公司的非执行董事，向本公司交出或在本公司的要求下销毁阁下准备的或阁下为本公司董事所拥

有的所有顾客及客户清单、通信文件及所有其它文件、文书及记录。阁下无权及不能保留任何以上所述的副本。以上所述的所有权及版权属于本公司所有。

This letter of appointment shall be governed and construed in its entirety by the laws of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China ("**Hong Kong**"). The parties herein hereby irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of the Hong Kong courts.
